What is parkrun?

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- Non-profit organisation
- Weekly events in open space
- 5k on Saturday and 2k (junior parkrun) on Sunday
- Bottom up: demand driven
- Organised by volunteers
- Free
- Register once: participate anywhere

parkrun UK's growth



- 486 5k events
- 196 2k (junior parkrun) events
- 13,000 people register every week
- 120,000 (5k) and 13,000 (2k) runners/walkers per week
- 12,000 weekly volunteers
- 1.6 million participants

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A global local intervention

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1299 locations across 19 territories

Over 200,000 participants every weekend

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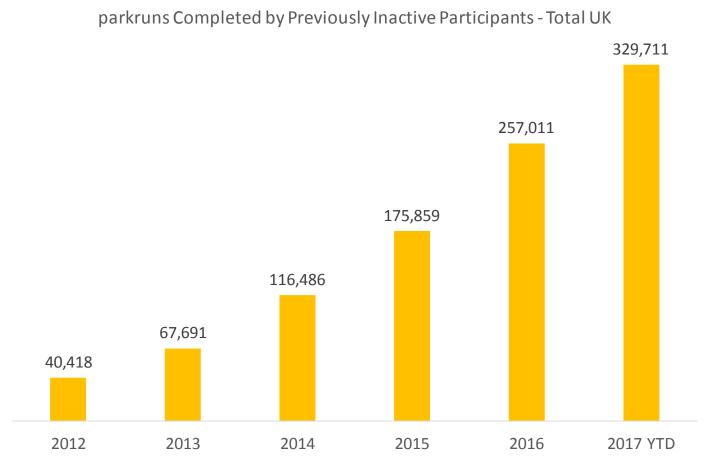
Strategies for engaging the least active

Data and Research:	Develop and share insight and understanding
Projects (collaboration):	Long term conditions & disabilities, areas of social deprivation, social prescribing, custodial estate
Operations:	Welcome briefings and support roles (Tail Walker, BSL support, VI guides)
Staffing:	Outreach Ambassadors and Champions
Communication:	Language and imagery. Make it real. Tell human stories

More than ¼ million parkruns were completed in the UK in 2016 by participants who were previously inactive. The share of total walks, jogs and runs completed is steadily rising and stands at 5.9% in 2017.

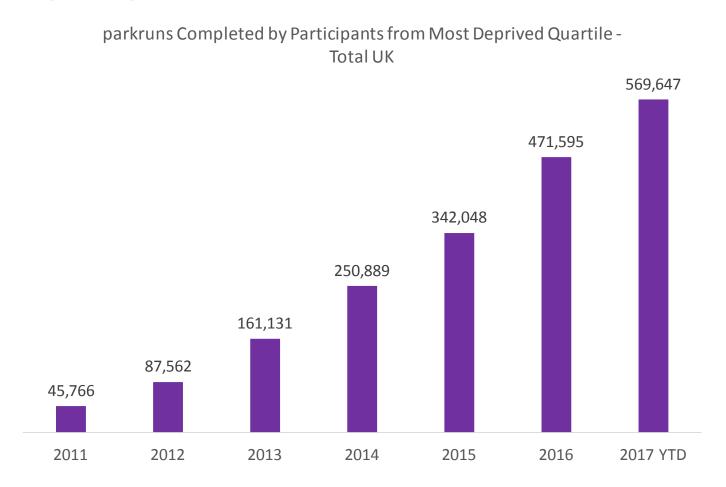

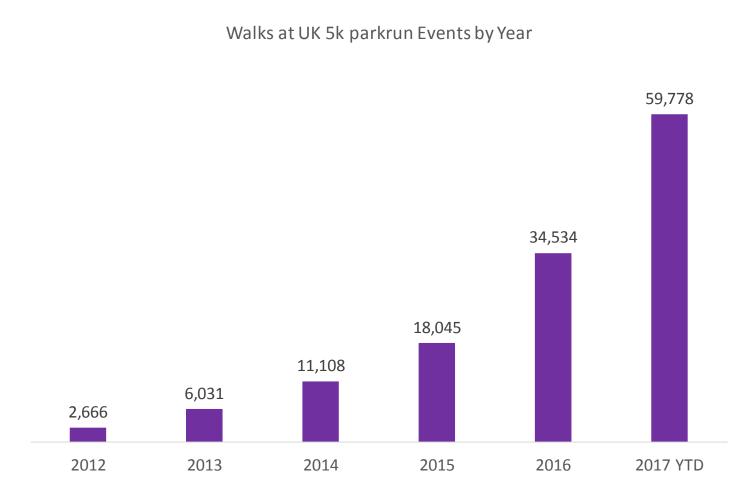

With a month still to go, well over half a million parkruns have been completed by participants from the most deprived quartile of the UK in 2017.

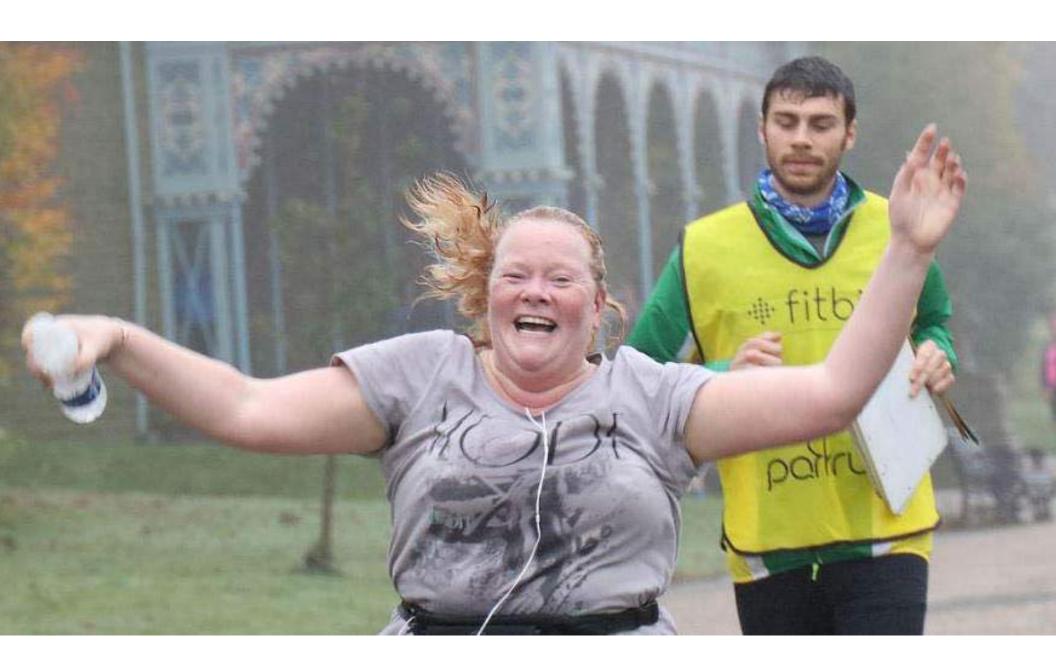


There has been a sharp increase in the number of walks (taking 50 minutes or more) completed at 5k parkrun events in the UK, with more than 60,000 to occur in 2017.
