

Listen out for the number.  
**3 > Get into groups of 3 and try to create a word which contains your 3 letters. For example, RGT > RiGhT / ReGisTer / ReGisTration.**  
**4 > Get into groups of 4 and try to create a word which contains your 4 letters. For example, NSTA > iNSTAnt / iNSTAgram.**

**Well done! You get:**

- 1 point for each word created
- 1 point for each letter in the longest word
- 2 points for each word linked to the theme or weekly spellings
- 2 points for being the fastest / most co-operative team



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# The Car Reg Game



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## Focus, Resources & Organisation

### Focus

A fun, versatile game involving creativity in word construction and spelling.

### Resources

Letter tags as appropriate for age/abilities.  
Belts.

### Organisation

Place the tags face down on the floor.  
Each child has a belt.  
Mini whiteboards and pens.

## Physical Challenge

Ask children to travel around the space in different ways, but ensuring they do not touch the tags. Children can:

- Walk
- Jog
- Run
- Run flicking heels up
- Run knees high
- Skip
- Bounce
- As above, but forwards/backwards/sideways

On a given signal, each child picks up a tag, places it on their belt and resumes travelling.

## Thinking Challenge

Shout out a number, for example:  
**3 > Children get themselves into groups of 3 and try to create a word which contains their 3 letters. For example, RGT > RiGhT / ReGisTer / ReGisTration**  
**4 > Children get themselves into groups of 4 and try to create a word which contains their 4 letters - NSTA > iNSTAnt / iNSTAgram**

For older children you may wish to try more letters / larger groups and longer words.

The aim is to create the longest word possible with their designated letters.

### Scoring System

1 point for each word created.  
 1 point for each letter in the longest word.  
 2 points for each word linked to the theme or weekly spellings.  
 2 points for being the fastest or most co-operative team.
